FRIENDS OF INSKIP SCHOOL PRIZE DRAW

INTRODUCTION - We are starting a monthly prize draw for friends, family and locals of Inskip C of E School to raise money to provide facilities and experiences for the children which the current budget does not allow for. It will also bring the community together and the chances of winning a nice cash prize will be much greater than buying a scratch card each month! Note: The school has purchased a small lotteries license from the Wyre Borough Council No.SL0333

RULES

- Each number costs £2 per month
- There is a prize draw at the end of every month from November 2021 to October 2022
- There is no limit to the amount of numbers 1 person can purchase
- You must commit to the prize draw for 12 months and pay £24 up front (per number required)
- The list of members will be shown on the Friends of Inskip School Facebook page against their number (s) and it will be updated whenever members are added. A paper copy can be provided on request if you do not have access to Facebook.
- You must be 16 or over to participate
- If there are 100 numbers purchased, the winner will receive £100 prize money and the school will receive a £100 donation (i.e. 50% to the winner, 50% to the school)
- New members can join at any time and commit to the remaining number of months up to October 2022.
- The prize draw will be made by using either a random number generator, live on Facebook on the last Friday of the month or be picked by the children from a hat in their Worship Assembly and the winners will be contacted that day and their cash prize will be delivered as soon as possible following the draw.

COVID-19

Please do not send your child in to school if they or members of your household have coronavirus symptoms or have tested positive in the last 10 days.

Symptoms are

- A high temperature—this means you feel hot to the touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste—this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child shows any of these symptoms at school we will ring you immediately and expect you to come and collect your child.
