

Our EYFS curriculum is topic, interest and needs led. Our EYFS children learn through an enquiry based & curiosity approach and is child initiated whenever possible. As the EYFS, Y1 and Y2 are one class where their learning is planned, taught and assessed by one teacher the EYFS termly learning is planned under the umbrella of these topic titles above and is sometimes inspired by the content of the Y1&2's learning where they learn as a whole class with differentiated activities and expectations. Maths planning – we follow the White Rose Maths scheme of work.

<p>Communication and Language: We will be getting to know the children at the beginning of the year and providing lots of opportunities for them to feel excited about school life. Storytelling through role play.</p>	<p>PSED: Our theme for the term is relationships and we will explore the questions; 'What makes a good friend?' and 'What is bullying?'</p>
<p>Physical Development: Fine and gross motor skills activities, Scissor skills, finger gym activities, moving in the outdoors. In PE lessons they will develop fundamental movement skills through different topics.</p>	<p>Literacy: Oral storytelling, labelling, story maps, caption writing, letter formation. In phonics we will be learning the sounds and begin to learn high frequency words in Phase 2.</p>
<p>Mathematics: Learning through White Rose Maths topics of Getting to know you, Just like me!, It's me 1 2 3! And Light and Dark. In these topics over the term through group and continuous provision activities the children will explore a variety of areas in Number, Measure and Spatial Thinking.</p>	<p>Understanding The World: Ideas for learning/lines of enquiry will be sparked and led by the children's interests and enhanced by the themes of 'On Safari', "People Who Help Us' and the themes explored by Year 1 and 2.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts and Design: Music and instruments. Variety of art activities available at the Creation Station and in continuous provision activities outdoors and indoors.</p>	<p>RE: This term we will be exploring the questions; Why do people of faith say thank you to God at Harvest Time? How do Christians express their faith thorough art? Why was the birth of Jesus such good news?</p>
