By the end of Key Stage 1 children are expected to:	
٠	talk about God as creator of the world who loves us.
٠	know that God is three in one, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
٠	be able to retell both the nativity and Easter stories.
٠	use religious words to talk about the celebrations of Christmas, Easter and Pentecost.
٠	know that Christians believe Jesus is the Son of God who died on the cross and rose again.
٠	know that Jesus had 12 special friends called disciples.
٠	know that the Bible is our holy book and it contains God's big story, the salvation plan.
٠	be able to retell stories of Jesus' miracles.
٠	have visited a church and confidently talk about their experience and what they have
	learnt.
٠	have had opportunity to ask reflective questions that wonder about Christian practice,
	values and beliefs.
•	be able to give examples of how Christians, put their beliefs into action.
•	know the names and significance of holy books from other faiths.
٠	know the places where people of other faiths worship.
٠	be developing a sense of their own values and the values of others.
•	have experienced taking part in the celebration of Harvest Festival.
