Years 1 and 2

Topics: The Wind In The Willows and Buckets and Spades

<p>English: In the first half term we will be reading and writing our own animal adventure stories, writing recounts in the form of letters and looking at classic poems linked to our topic The Wind In The Willows. In the second half term we will be studying stories on a theme, explanations and poetry on a theme linked to our topic Buckets and Spades.</p>	<p>Phonics/Spelling: Year 1 children will be learning all the sounds in Phase 5. Year 2 children will be learning the spelling rules in Phase 6. This term the Year 1 children will have their phonics screening check.</p>
<p>Mathematics: In the first half term Year 1 will be learning about multiplication and fractions within the topic 'Number' and position and direction within the topic of 'Geometry'. Year 2 children will be learning about length and height within the topic 'Measurement' and Position and Direction within the topic 'Geometry'. In the second half term the Year 1 children will be learning about money and time in the topic 'Measurement' and place value (within 100) in the topic 'Number'. Year 2 children will also be learning about time plus mass, capacity and temperature.</p>	<p>Science: We will be learning about living things and their habitats in the first half term and in the second, uses of everyday materials looking at the suitability of different materials for particular uses.</p>
<p>Art and Design: This term we will be exploring print making and collage linked to a theme.</p>	<p>Design and Technology: Our area of learning is textiles and the children will be learning to sew a running stitch as they make a pouch for Toad (the character from The wind In The Willows' to keeps his keys in!</p>

<p>History: During the second half of the term our History learning will be learning about the seaside now and then looking at Blackpool and St Annes as seaside towns in the past and as they are today. We will also be learning about Grace Darling and why she is remembered today.</p>	<p>Geography: In our Geography study we will be learning about seasonal and daily weather.</p>
<p>RE: This term our RE theme is Judaism, in the first half term we will be learning about Shabbat and exploring the question 'Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?'. In the second half of the term we will be learning about Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur and exploring the question 'Are Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur important to Jewish children?'</p>	<p>PSHE: Our theme for the first half of term is health and wellbeing and we will explore the question 'Who Keeps Us Safe?' During the second half of term our theme is living in the wider world and we will be thinking about the question ' How can we look after each other and the wider world?'</p>
<p>PE: During the first half term we will be developing fundamental movement skills focusing on activities catching and bouncing a ball and then athletics. In the second half of term we will be progressing, moving and learning new skills through dance and games.</p>	<p>Music: Using the Charanga Music Scheme our topic is called 'Having fun with improvisation' – What songs can we sing to help us through the day?</p>
<p>Computing: In the first half of the term we will be introduced to early programming concepts where we will be moving a robot. In the second half of the term we will progress onto on-screen programming through ScrathJr. The children will explore the way a project looks by investigation sprites and backgrounds. Online safety, using I pads to research information and using apps for other areas of learning will continue.</p>
