Spring Term 2023 Reception Topics: Jack and The Beanstalk and Toys (Mother's Day & Easter)

Our EYFS curriculum is topic, interest and needs led. Our EYFS children learn through an enquiry based & curiosity approach and is child initiated whenever possible. As the EYFS, Y1 and Y2 are one class where their learning is planned, taught and assessed by one teacher the EYFS termly learning is planned under the umbrella of these topic titles above and is sometimes inspired by the content of the Y1&2's learning where they learn as a whole class with differentiated activities and expectations. Maths planning – we follow the White Rose Maths scheme of work.

<p>Communication and Language: This term the children will be listening to lots of traditional tales. They will develop their communication and language skills through a wide variety of activities throughout the day during play, continuous provision activities, role play, guided and independent activities.</p>	<p>PSED: Our first theme for the term is living in the wider world and we will explore the question 'What jobs do people do?'. Our second theme is health and wellbeing and we will explore the question 'What helps us to stay safe?'</p>
<p>Physical Development: Fine and gross motor skills activities, Scissor skills, finger gym activities, moving in the outdoors. In PE lessons they will develop fundamental movement skills through different topics. This term their topics will be 'Castles', 'Space', 'The Hungry Caterpillar' and 'Rosie's Walk'.</p>	<p>Literacy: Oral storytelling, labelling, story maps, caption writing, letter formation. The children will be doing lots of writing linked to their themes and things that interest them. In phonics we continue to learn to read and blend the sounds taught in Phase 2 using the Red Rose Letters and Sounds Phonics scheme as well as learning through practical games and activities.</p>

<p>Mathematics: Learning through White Rose Maths topics of Alive in 5, Growing 6,7,8 and Building 9 &10. Through these they will develop their number, measure, shape and spatial thinking skills.</p>	<p>Understanding The World: Ideas for learning/lines of enquiry will be sparked and led by the children's interests and enhanced by the themes of 'Jack and the beanstalk', 'Toys' and the themes explored by Year 1 and 2.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts and Design: Music and instruments, learning the song Zootime and playing instruments. Variety of art activities available at the Creation Station and in continuous provision activities outdoors and indoors.</p>	<p>RE: This term we will be exploring the questions; 'What made Jesus special?' What do you think is the most important part of the Easter story?'</p>
