Spring Term 2023

Years 1 and 2

Topics: Growth and Green Fingers and Family Album

<p>English: In the first half term we will be looking at classic stories, instructions and traditional rhymes. In each of these genres the children will be reading and writing their own versions linked to stories we read and cross curricular writing opportunities arising from our topic called Growth and Green Fingers.</p> <p>In the second half term we will be moving on to looking at traditional tales a writing and new tale based on a traditional one for our EYFS children to enjoy. We will also be learning how to write recounts effectively and recount a family event.</p>	<p>Phonics/Spelling: Year 1 children continue learning the sounds in Phase 5. Year 2 children will continue to learn and apply the spelling rules in Phase 6.</p> <p>We will be using Red Rose Letters and Sounds Phonics scheme as well as learning through practical games and activities.</p>
<p>Mathematics: In the first half term Year 1 will be learning about place value (within 20), addition and subtraction (within 20) within the topic 'Number'. Year 2 children will be learning about money and multiplication and division.</p> <p>In the second half term the Year 1 children will be learning about place value (within 50) and then length and height as well as weight and volume in the topic 'Measurement'.</p>	<p>Science: We will be learning about the basic structure of plants and observing growth over time.</p>

<p>Year 2 children will continue their learning about multiplication and division before also be learning about length and height. They will also learn about mass, capacity and temperature.</p>	
<p>History: During the topic Family Album the children will be developing their knowledge and understanding about the past by looking at their lives and the lives of members of their families.</p>	<p>Geography: During the topic Family Album our Geography study we will be learning name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.</p>
<p>Art and Design: This term we will be drawing feathers and making sculptural birds.</p>	<p>Design and Technology: In the first half of the term we will be exploring mechanisms and making a moving monster.</p>
<p>RE: This term we will be exploring the questions; 'What made Jesus special?' What do you think is the most important part of the Easter story?'</p>	<p>PSHE: Our theme for the term is relationships and we will explore the questions; 'What jobs do people do?' and 'What helps us to stay safe?'</p>
<p>PE: In the first half of term we will be doing a dance unit with the theme of Explorers. In the second half of term we will be doing a unit developing our fundamental multi skills for overarm throws.</p>	<p>Music: Using the Charanga Music Scheme our topic is called Zootime. Our learning is focused all around one song and the children will learn to sing it, pl instruments and improve their skills.</p>
<p>Computing: In the first half of the term we will be developing programming skills and learning about robot algorithms. In the second half of the term we will be developing our skills in data and information learning about pictograms. Online safety, using I pads to research information and using apps for other areas of learning will continue.</p>
