History:	Geography:

Neil Armstrong but will also look at other exciting explorers such as
Amelia Earhart the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean
and Ibn Battuta who explored for 29 years visiting India, China, West
Africa and Europe in the early 1300s!

and comparing how life and in particular, farming, is different to our village, Inskip.

RE:

During the first half term our RE theme is 'Jesus as a Friend' and exploring the question 'Was it always easy for Jesus to show us friendship?'. During the second half term our concept is 'Salvation' and we will be exploring the question 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?'

PSHE:

Our theme for the first half of term is 'Health and Wellbeing' and we will be exploring 'What makes us healthy?'. During the second half of term our theme is 'Living in the wider world' and we will be thinking about the question 'What can we do with money?'

PE:

During the first half term we will be developing fundamental movement skills; rolling, jumping, bouncing a ball and rolling a ball through a topic called 'Supertato'. We will also be exploring different ways to travel in gymnastics lessons.

In the second half of term we will be showing character and emotion through dance moves and creating a dance through a theme of 'Toy Story'. We will also be developing fundamental movement skills through a topic of 'Zog'. We will develop skills of running, jumping, hopping, travelling fast and learning to throw overarm.

Music:

Using the Charanga Music Scheme our first music topic is called 'Introducing Tempo and Dynamics' – How does music make the world a better place?

In the second half term we will be learning through the topic 'Combining Pulse, Rhythm and Pitch' – How does music help us to understand our neighbours?

Computing:

Online safety, using I pads to research information for other areas of learning. In the first half term our focus will be digital writing and in the second half term it will be grouping data.

Design & Technology:

In the first half term our topic will be Mechanisms – Wheels and axels where the children will be designing and making a model moon buggy. In the second half term our topic will be food and we will be preparing fruit and vegetables linking our learning to our science topic.
