Dear Parents / Carers,

Firstly, could we say thank you to all parents & carers that park considerately when dropping off and picking up children at Inskip St Peters Primary school. We have, however, received complaints regarding inconsiderate parking on Scholars Chase and the area around your child's school. It has been reported that vehicles have been obstructing resident's driveways and using residents' driveways to reverse into. In addition, vehicles have been parked too close to junctions and on corners during school dropping off and picking-up times in mornings and afternoons. This is putting the safety of children and others at risk.

How you can help – vehicles must not be parked:

- On a dropped kerb
- Obstructing someone's driveway or property.
- On a footpath or an area used by pedestrians
- Near a school entrance
- Within 10 meters (32 feet) of a junction
- On yellow zig-zag markings

This letter is to make you aware that if we continue to receive reports regarding inconsiderate and dangerous parking, further action will be taken against drivers who continually put others at risk. Parents should be aware of their actions and take more consideration in the future.

This is about keeping your children and others safe around school.
