Swimming Lessons

This week the swimming pool will be erected so that for the final two weeks of this term each of our pupils will receive daily swimming lessons.

Every pupil will use the pool each school day from Monday the 18th March till Thursday 28th March.

The children will change into and out of their swimwear inside school before walking in their dressing gown and sliders to the pool (windows overlooking houses will be blocked). Each school day from Monday the 18th March till Thursday 28th March your child will need to bring to school

· a swimming costume/trunks

 \cdot a dry towel

 \cdot a swimming hat if they have long hair (to prevent their vision being impeded during the session)

\cdot a dressing gown

· flip flops / slippers / sliders

Jewellery must not be worn and we ask that goggles are only worn in exceptional circumstances. If you believe that your child needs to wear goggles, please contact me for a form to enable you to request an exception.

Swimming aids are provided by the pool company.

For ease of changing all pupils may wear baggy jogging bottoms and a sweatshirt (ie our PE kit) each day during these 2 weeks.
