A recent study has shown that 1 in 3 child car seats are not fitted correctly.

Lancashire County Council's road Safety Team has funded 15 **child car seat safety events** to be delivered by Road Safety Great Britain's national advisors for child car seats and supported by Road Safety Officers from Lancashire County Council. These free community events will take place at a variety of supermarkets in specifically targeted areas and will **aim to support and educate parents / carers / grandparents and anyone who drives with children in their vehicle on how to correctly fit a child car seat in their vehicle.**

The team will demonstrate how to correctly install the child car seat and inform the driver if a car seat is unsuitable for any reason. In addition, drivers will be offered a range of car seat and general road safety literature to take away with them.

Many of the mistakes people make with their child car seats are simple and easy to avoid and potentially lifesaving, including:

- Seat belts need tightening
- Harnesses not being in the right position
- Incorrect use of head supports

The closest car seat safety event to us takes place on the **8th May at Booths Lytham FY8 5EG**
