Blind football is played in two halves of 20 minutes. The aim of the game is to score more goals than the other team.

Behind the net each team has a guide to help get the ball on target.



The guide and goalkeeper are allowed to shout instructions to their team.

Outfield players wear blindfolds so they all have the same vision.

Goalkeeper can be fully sighted.

VOY!

When players go in to tackle, they shout 'Voy!' (Spanish for 'I'm going').

The ball is audible. It has a rattle or bell inside, so players can hear where it is.

Played in teams of five.

Spectators must be VERY quiet... except when a goal is scored!
