New after school detention expectations at Inspire Academy

Dear parent/carer,

Now that we are heading in to a new school year, which will hopefully be a lot more settled than our previous 2 years, I am writing to inform you of our new expectations regarding after school detentions.

Until now we have always put a 30 minute after school detention in place for all pupils. However, as an Academy we are now going to increase the detention time to 1 hour, but, each pupil will be given the opportunity to reduce this back to 30 minutes as long as they follow all instructions during this time.

There are 2 main reasons that we have made the changes to our detention process:

- By increasing the sanction time, we hope to deter pupils from undesirable behaviours that lead to detentions.
- Should a pupil receive an after school detention, they are more likely to demonstrate the desired behaviours when given an opportunity to reduce the sanction time.

If a pupil is given an after school detention, it is the parents/carers responsibility to come and collect their child/ward, as this shows good collaborative working between home and school and is more likely to reduce reoccurring detentions.

Please see the attached 'after school detention expectations' sheet. We would appreciate you taking the time to share this with your child/ward. This will also be displayed around school.

After School detention expectations 2021/22

ALL after school detentions will be for <u>1 hour</u>, however, if pupils follow all of the below instructions, the detention will be reduced to <u>30 minutes</u>.

- Go straight to the allocated detention classroom and sit down quietly.
- Complete the required work in silence (unless asking questions regarding the work).
- Follow all staff instructions throughout the detention.
