### **Notes on the revised school day timetable:**

- Breakfast club extended by 5 minutes to allow pupils to eat and staff to deal with any issues from home.
- Shorter morning tutor due to the extended tutor time at the end of the day (enough time in the morning to fill out day sheet). Assembly on a Monday morning also shorter due to celebration assembly at the end of the day.
- Afternoon tutor time extended to address any issues linked to behaviour focus/theme and complete literacy, numeracy, PSHE work based on T&L focus/theme and British Values. Possibly used as a reward on a Thursday for the form with the most points, or any other criteria we feel needs addressing as part of behaviour data.

These revised hours still mean that all pupils are accessing 30 hrs per week of education including all social times which link to targets from their EHCP.

Staff will be able to run more enrichment activities after school to support the needs of our pupils, within their contracted working hours. This is also the same for a consistent sanctions approach in terms of after school catch up if necessary.
