NE and AD – Welcome to all and congratulations on being voted school council reps. Badges handed out Green KS3 and Blue KS4.

Welcome Introduction to Lisa Quigley our new Speech and Language Therapist, Lisa explained to students what a speech and language therapist does.

Expectations explained to students that they are representing the school inside and outside the building.
