History - Must Farm, A Bronze Age Settlement

### Vocabulary

Prehistory	Prehistory is a large period of time in our past before humans could write.
Iron Age	A prehistoric period that followed the Bronze Age, when weapons and tools came to be made of iron.
Bronze Age	A prehistoric period that followed the Stone Age and came before the Iron Age, when weapons and tools were made of bronze rather than stone.
Neolithic	Neolithic is the later part of the Stone Age, when ground or polished stone weapons and implements were used.
Mesolithic	Mesolithic is part of the Stone Age, between the Palaeolithic and Neolithic periods.
Must Farm	Must Farm is a <b>Bronze Age archaeological site consisting of five houses raised on stilts above a river</b> and built around 950 BC in Cambridgeshire, England.
Excavation	Excavation means to dig up.
Settlement	A place where people live.
