Spanish - Carnival and
Playground Games

Children will revisit language learning from the autumn term. The units starts with learning about Carnival in Spain and how it is celebrated. The children make carnival masks following instructions in Spanish. The children will then revisit colours, numbers, months and days and will be introduced to the question and answer for age and learn some playground games.

Through songs, games, native speaker clips, and independent tasks, they will explore the following content, topics and language:

- Discover the culture and celebration of Carnival
- Learn a carnival song
- Make a carnival mask

- Revisit numbers
- Learn to ask and answer age
- Revisit days and months

- 2) join in with a song about colours and days of the week
- 3) remember six colours
- 4) remember some numbers and play games with them
- 5) ask and answer my age in Spanish
- 6) play games with days and months
