Progress on site to date

Kier is nearing completion of this new build 630 place primary school. We have completed Phase 1 of the new building, which involved Key Stage 1 classrooms, offices, the Library, School Hall, Staff areas and Kitchen along with external play and communal areas.

We are on programme to complete and hand over the project in Spring 2016.



Ongoing activities

Phase 2 is nearing completion, with carpets and final decorations remaining. External play areas are now complete.

The toucan crossing on Lynn Road is currently under construction and is due for completion in late March. Traffic lights will be in use during this time. At the same time, we are carrying out resurfacing works and other improvements associated with the crossing to avoid future disruption.

The site access roads continue to progress with drainage now complete and kerbs being installed.

Considerate Constructors Scheme

The site is registered with the Considerate Constructors Scheme, which is an independently audited assessment of a project's consideration for the local community, its operatives and the environment.

We were last audited in July 2015, and received 'Excellent' or 'Exceptional' in all five categories. As part of our commitment to the local community, we provided a weekly placement on site for a member of the local 6th form throughout the Autumn term.

Working hours

Our general working hours are 07:30 - 17:30 Monday to Friday. Occasionally, we may work on Saturday mornings from 08:00 - 13:00.

Car Parking

All contractor parking is on site in a dedicated parking area adjacent to the site accommodation. This keeps disruption to an absolute minimum.

Deliveries and site traffic

All traffic enters and exits the site via an existing field entrance, and all deliveries are directed straight into site to avoid disturbance and traffic congestion on the public highway. A gateman is located at the entrance to control and direct deliveries.
