#### Free school meals:

Free school meals are available for families and carers that receive one of the following:

- Universal credit
- Income support
- Income based job seekers allowance
- Income related employment and support allowance
- Working Tax credit run on
- Child tax credit but no element of working tax credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16 190

If you apply and qualify for Free School Meals, our school will receive additional funding called Pupil Premium, up to £1320 a year.

Even though all children in Key Stage 1 receive Universal Infant Free School Meals, we can only benefit from Pupil Premium funding if you apply and are eligible for Free School Meals.
