Head Teacher's Comment - from Helen Davies

Fire Alarm

Thank you for your patience during our unscheduled fire alarm test yesterday afternoon. Whilst the timing of this may not have been ideal the children and staff did very well and evacuated the building in good time and followed directions well. However the drill did highlight that we had not communicated with parents what they should do should the fire alarm sound at either school drop off or pick up.

Should this happen again parents will need to go immediately to the back of the school field, away from the children. They should remain there until all children are back in their classrooms and accounted for. Parents may then move to collect their children as normal.

This is so that staff have a clear view of the children at all times and children are not distracted and thus able to concentrate on any instructions and remain silent. With lots of additional adults milling around it can be very difficult, especially for our younger children, to focus on the correct adult and not be drawn towards other adults they may know and therefore becoming separated from their class.

I'm sure you can appreciate that in such a situation it is essential that we can easily account for all the children in our care.

ITV news

We will have ITV news in school on Tuesday filming some of our year 5 students whilst they learn. A handful of children will be filmed practicing their handwriting and will be shown on or around the National Handwriting Day on23rd January.
