#### **Staffing Updates:**

### **Attendance:**

Attendance at school is mandatory and it is vitally important for the children's learning and wellbeing to be at school. This has obviously been made more difficult with COVID but if your child is well, without COVID symptoms or a sick bug, they should be in school. A child with a cold should be in school and if we are concerned about your child, we will always contact you. We expect the children's attendance to be at least 96% and any child who fall below this, causes us concern. If your child's attendance falls below 96%, your child's class teacher will have a conversation with you about this. If your child's attendance falls below 94%, you will be invited to a meeting with Mrs Surtees to discuss this further and the school will support you to ensure that your child's attendance improves. If your child's attendance falls below 90%, this is classed as persistent absence and outside agencies may need to get involved to support the family which may result in a penalty notice. Please ensure you send your child to school every day, do not take them out for any reason and arrive before the gates close at 0835.



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## **Maths Curriculum Evening:**

On the diary dates that was sent out at the beginning of term, you will notice that we had planned to hold a maths curriculum evening on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> January. Due to the current guidance, we are unable to hold this event in school and so unfortunately, it is cancelled.
