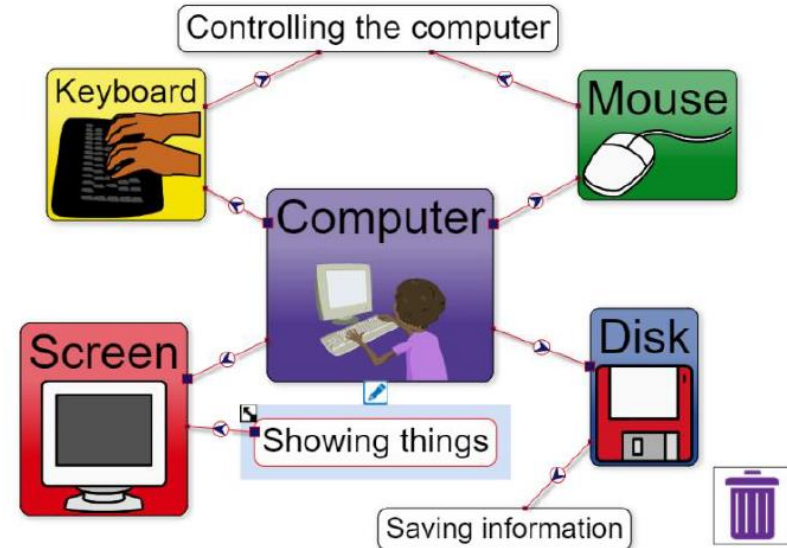





Vocabulary

debugging	Finding and correcting code to fix errors that stop the code from working.
hardware	The physical parts of a computing device e.g. processing 'chips', hard-drive, motherboard
input	Information (data) going into a computing device
output	Processed responses coming from the computer to a human operator e.g. sounds, graphics
peripheral	Any device (including sensors) used to enter information and instructions into a computer or to deliver the output to a human operator
procedure	A set of coding instructions that tell a computer how to run a program or calculation
routine	Any code that is used repeatedly during the a program or procedure
software	A complete set of programming/coding that makes a computer system work
sprite	A flat graphic or animation that is part of a larger scene e.g. a game character that can be moved
