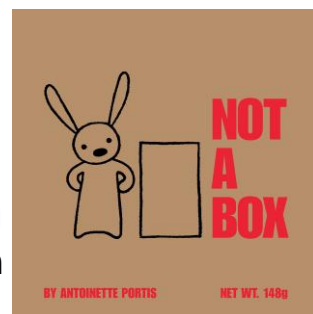

Key Concepts and Skills

In Little Gems Class, we follow the Early Years Framework which has 7 subject areas, Communication and Language, Physical Development and Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED), Literacy, Maths (Cognition), Expressive Arts and Understanding the World. Your children will experience a wide variety of lessons and activities which cover these areas. This half term, our topic is "Sing a Rainbow". Our main focus is on building relationships with our pupils to ensure they can achieve their potential. **Please remember to look at Evidence for Learning to see what your child is learning at school!**

Home Learning Curriculum Ideas

Cognition and Maths

For Cognition, you could make your own mystery box, where your child can explore different objects.



PSED



You could create a 'calm and safe' box using:

- Soft fabrics
- Cushions
- Familiar objects
- A favourite scent comfort item.



Communication

For Communication, you could read the story massage on the next page. Story massage promotes calmness and emotional regulation. You can pause while reading the story and see if your child would like 'more'.

Understanding the World

You could listen to some songs about the weather and talk about the weather outside. You could go for a walk in different weather or read the story massage on the pages below.



Literacy

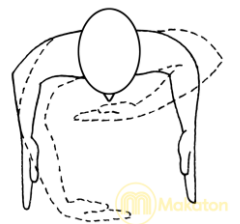
