Knowledge and Skills


Our theme this half term is 'special places' and will be based on the novel 'In my Mosque' and 'Going to Mecca'. We will be exploring our topic by creating unique sensory stories that take us on a special journey to discover what it is like to be in different places of worship. Smelling different scents, exploring different items of worship and investigating what food is eaten, will enable us to capture a focus on different 'special places'

Further to this, music will play a big part in exploring this terms topic, creating new rhythms' and rhymes during our soundboard lesson and lots of movement will be encouraged, using sensory props to topic music during our weekly dance massage.

Our weekly PSED session this term will be related to 'communities' where we will be engaging in lots of activities that involve peer interactions, celebrating our school community and engaging 1:1 with our friends. This half term is going to be jam packed with lots of fun and new learning experiences. Now lets get started.
