As you may be aware, the NHS Derby and Derbyshire Integrated Care Board (ICB) has been in the process of securing a new healthcare provider for schools across Derby and Derbyshire. The ICB recently completed a formal tendering process. However, at this stage, we have not received any further details regarding the plans moving forward.

We continue to meet regularly with all stakeholders and understand that they are working towards sharing more information with you at tomorrow's coffee morning. We have been assured that there will be no disruption to student care and that provisions will continue as normal. We hope to receive further details soon regarding any potential changes, such as the requirement for parents to send in syringes and other equipment, as previously mentioned in a prior letter.

To ensure that you have the opportunity to discuss these changes with the school, NurtureCare, and the ICB, we will be hosting another coffee morning tomorrow, on **Friday 14th February at 9:20 am**. This will be an opportunity for you to ask questions, share your thoughts, and gain a clearer understanding of how these changes may affect you and your child. We encourage you to attend for an open and supportive discussion.

We understand that this may be a time of uncertainty for you and your family, and we want to reassure you that we are committed to making this transition as smooth as possible while maintaining the highest standards of care for our students. Your continued support and engagement are greatly appreciated.
