

#### **Pupil Absence**

Please ensure that you call the school if your child is absent, for either illness or an appointment. We ask that you **call the school before 9:00am**, so that we can inform the class team. You should also call in to school, even if you've told the bus escort. Sometimes the message may not get to the right person.

We understand that children and young people are unwell from time to time and some of our students can be hospitalised for long periods due to ill health.

If your child is persistently absent, we may be in touch to discuss this with you. We also work alongside Derby City Councils Education Welfare Officer (EWO) to ensure that we can offer appropriate support where possible.

## **Medication**

If you send medication into school with your child please ensure you pass this directly to the transport staff so they can sign it over to the nursing team.

## Spare Clothing

As the new year starts it's always a good opportunity to remind all of our families to send in spare clothes for each of your children. Staff will send home soiled clothes on the san



send home soiled clothes on the same day in a separate bag. Please ensure you send in enough spare pads / nappies. Your child's class staff will call you or write in the home school diary to let you know if we don't have enough.

## Start/Finish Times

Our school day will continue at the same times of 9.20am until 3.40pm.

Please ensure your child arrives in school on time, if they are late into school you must complete a 'late slip' to explain the reason why. If pupils are persistently late we will be in touch with you

to provide any possible support. We understand the morning can sometimes be a challenging time, particularly for students who have regular morning seizures.



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
