Food from home

Effective from the start of the new school year in September 2024, we will no longer be able to heat or reheat food sent in from home for your children. This decision was not made lightly but was necessary to ensure compliance with our health and safety standards.

We recommend that any food cooked at home and intended to be consumed warm be sent to school in a vacuum flask that keeps food warm, such as a 'Thermos' flask. This method will ensure that your child can still enjoy a warm

meal without the need for reheating at school.
