Transport Applications



Derby City Council have sent the following message for us to share with families.

"We are consulting on the term dates for the academic years spanning 2025-26 and 2026-27. This revised consultation has arisen due to the feedback we received on the initial consultation which took place between December 2023 and January 2024. Consultation feedback identified that alternative term arrangements would impact positively on pupil attendance and achievement. Therefore, we are now consulting on Option A and Option B as detailed in the survey below. We are looking to set the dates for two academic years, 2025-2027, and then review again based on the impact these alternate dates might have." 

MOVE Meetings

The MOVE team have identified some students who they feel would benefit from becoming part of the MOVE programme. The first step of the MOVE process is to arrange a meeting between class staff, a MOVE senior practitioner, families and most importantly your child. At this meeting, the aim is to set goals that are important to your child and your family.

What is MOVE?

The MOVE programme and the physical curriculum at Ivy House place movement at the centre of learning. Being able to move allows us to learn much more effectively. The MOVE Programme is designed to help families, educators and therapists work together toward specific goals for each individual pupil.

MOVE is activity-based, giving the pupils many opportunities to improve their sitting, standing and walking skills while participating in activities of daily living.
