Summer - Journeys

This unit of work focuses on the journeys that the children may experience. They build on their work of the short journey they make to school. Children will look at journeys they may have made further afield using a variety of transport, and consider the history of transport and how this has changed. They think about their life journey so far. Children learn about the changes they have experienced within their own family. Children will look at changes in the life-cycles of animals.

Reading and Writing: Our children will continue with Read, Write Inc. Children have progressed incredibly and will continue to deepen their understanding of sounds and word reading. We will also be enjoying a range of other stories as we explore our love of reading. Children are learning to write simple sentences and continuing to refine their letter formation.

In Maths this term we are exploring building numbers and counting beyond 10. We will begin to learn about addition and subtraction and investigate halving and doubling. Children will deepen their understanding of pattern, including number bonds to 10.

Science: In science we will be thinking about how humans, animals and plants change over time. We will investigate what they need to grow. We will look at different habitats that are further afield.

Art: Printing and Collage unit including: the work of Eric Carle, exploring texture with different materials, combining materials to make collages, basic printing skills

PSHE: Being My Best, Growing and Changing

Music: We will be listening and appraising Funk music Revisiting nursery rhymes and action songs. Playing instruments and improvising using our voices. We will share and perform our learning.

RE: Looking at stories from a range of world religions and examining what they can teach us, learning about different religion's special places such as church, mosque, synagogue.

P.E.: Dance and Games
