This term our curriculum covers the following areas:

**Literacy**: This term, we will be exploring a range of narrative and non-fiction texts. We will start by writing a news report before looking at explanatory texts and stories from other cultures. We will secure the use of the following punctuation: capital letters and full stops; commas after fronted adverbials; possessive apostrophe for singular and plural nouns.

We will be reading How to Train Your Dragon by Cressida Cowell as our Class Novel.

Mathematics: We start the term by looking at multiplication and division. We will learn about factor pairs and how to use them before moving on to multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. We will also look at multiplying two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using a formal written layout. The topic we will look at next will be perimeter and length.



Our Science work this term focuses on Animals including humans- food chains. We will construct food chains and identify producers, predators and prey. Our second topic is Electricity. We will construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers. We will also identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit. Finally, we will recognise some common conductors and insulators.

In Geography, we will look at Migration. We will explore the types of migration and the impact of it. We will look at the economic impact of how Climate Change is beginning to have an effect on migration.

R.E: Hinduism. Pilgrimage to the River Ganges. We will explore the question- Would visiting the River Ganges feel special to a non-Hindu?

DT: Structures - Shell structures. We will make a shell structure to use as a sturdy treasure box. We will investigate strengthening materials.

PSHE: Keeping Myself Safe. We will define the terms: danger, risk and hazard and be able to explain ways to manage and minimise risk to ourselves. We will learn how to use medicines safely and understand the term 'drugs'. We will revisit ways to keep ourselves safe online and be alert to dangers.

Music: STOP. We will explore Rap music looking the structure, instruments and rhythms created. We will produce and perform our own Rap.

French: In French, we will be learning about Ma Famille. We will learn how to tell somebody the members, names and various ages of either our own or a fictional family in French. We will also be developing our ability to listen attentively to the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears in French learning the associated vocabulary.

P.E: Dance, yoga, fitness and handball.
