Weekly update 22nd September

Dear parents and carers,

Our second full week back and lots of superb learning has already taken place. We are really impressed with everyone and how they are working really hard to go the extra mile.

Online Safety and Changes with our IPADs: From today, we have changed how the children will access the web on both our lpads and on our computers. AS you know, we constantly want to make sure that all our children are safe when working online. From today, we have added a new monitoring tool called SENSO. SENSO monitors the websites that your child is accessing and checks what they are typing on the keyboard or searching for online. This is an extra safeguard that we provide, alongside blocking websites that may be inappropriate. This will mean a change to the way in which your child accesses the internet as they will now use the SENSO app rather than Safari. This will mean that we can all feel confident that when searching, the ipad will be a secure device and that if your child types in, searches for, or accesses anything inappropriate then it is logged and we are alerted. Importantly, this monitoring is in place during the school holidays and at weekends, as well as during school time. In some cases, where we think that a child might be at risk because of something they have typed or seen online, we may want to follow up quickly. From now, the app (SENSO), will send a pop-up notification on the screen for your child, signposting them to access external support agencies – providing phone numbers and links. If this happens outside of school time, we will respond once we return to school time. Whilst this will monitor and filter searches on the web (WWW) you will still need to be vigilant when children are using IPADS at home. SENSO will not monitor or filter content that is accessed via APPS - like the YOUTUBE APP. You must make sure that you continue to apply your own Parental Controls with rigor. Smart watches: Please can we remind parents that smartwatches with visual or audio recording capabilities are not allowed in school. For Safeguarding reasons there are some children in each class who do not have photo or video permissions and recording of them may place them at risk and would breach GDPR. This would be reportable to the ICO.

Lost Property: We have already amassed a number of jumpers and coats in our Lost Property Boxes. Please could you encourage your child to look for their missing items of clothes. Our Lost Property Box is located just inside playground entrance.
