

# Year 2

## Welcome to Year 2!

Well done to everyone so far, as our children have settled in beautifully and our classrooms have been busy and cheerful.

<u>The Year 2 Team</u> Our Year 2 team this year is: 2H: Mrs Agnew 2W: Mrs Leck

We also have 3 Teaching Assistants who will be supporting the year group: Mrs Little, Mrs Stephenson and Mrs Jackson.

This term our focus is history. We begin by learning about The Great Fire of London and comparing life then and now. We will be studying the Moon Landings after half term. Through the study of the Moon Landings, Neil Armstrong and Katherine Johnson, children are introduced to the explicit idea of significance. Children identify a historical global event, explain why this is significant and the impact on lives, past, and present (significance). Children explore this by investigating some of the main events of the moon landing. They gain an appreciation of character strengths of such significant individuals as Neil Armstrong and Katherine Johnson by looking at the adversity and challenges they faced.

In art this half term, we will look at colour and the artist Mondrian. After half term, in DT, we will be designing and making our own lunar rovers. Your children will be taught how to measure, mark out and cut using junior hacksaws and craft knives. In science, we are learning about how we keep ourselves fit and healthy and life cycles of common animals. We learn about exercise, hygiene and nutrition. We will also think about how we grow and change looking at the life cycle of humans and animals.

Our focus in IT is internet safety.

In RE we are looking at 'What did Jesus teach us?'.

Your child also has a weekly music lesson, PHSE and two sessions of PE a week.

In English, we will be continuing developing our reading skills in our Read Write Inc programme. We will again be in colour groups for this. Please keep helping us by reading the colour books at home. Use the instructions in the covers to help you work your way through the texts. Children who are off the programme will be on book band colours and will take part in guided reading sessions in place of RWInc. All children will then have a daily writing session, beginning with basic sentence structure and making sense.

Finally in Mathematics / Numeracy. We will start the half term by looking at the Place Value of numbers before moving on to Addition.

We begin by remembering numbers to 20 before quickly moving to counting up to 100. We will investigate how numbers are made by partitioning and then practice writing numbers to 100 in words. We will then explore these numbers by comparing and ordering numbers and amounts. Before finally counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and then 3's.

We will then move on to addition practising our number facts to IO and 20. We will then look at number bonds (ways of making) numbers to IOO. We will practise adding IO to a number and adding 3 Idigit numbers together.



**PE DAYS:** PE for this half term is Monday afternoon for both classes. Tuesday morning for 2H and Thursday morning for 2W.

## Uniform and PE Kit
