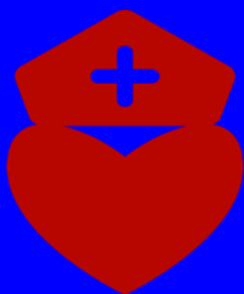
Attendance Winners:

3rd place (box of chocolates) Zack in Year 1

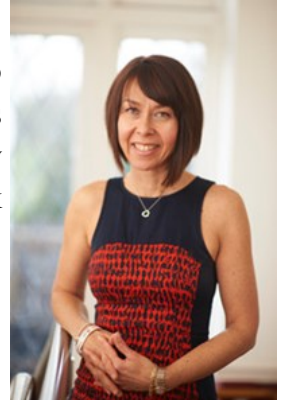

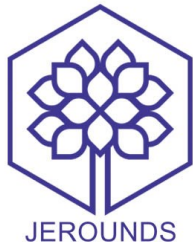

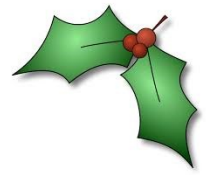


Christmas at Jerounds
