Consistent language is used by all school adults within an environment where children feel safe, cared for and respected. Why?</p> <p>Well, in academic terms, it is not WHAT pupils need to learn, but, HOW they learn it best? Metacognition is asking pupils to think about how they learn successfully.</p> <p><i>What should I do first?</i></p> <p><i>Is anything confusing to me?</i></p> <p><i>Can I explain what I have learned?</i></p> <p><i>Should I ask for extra help?</i></p> <p><i>Why did I get this answer wrong?</i></p> <p><i>Can I apply this in different contexts?</i></p> <p><i>How can I do better next time?</i></p> <p><u>Outcomes for pupils:</u></p> <p>Plan more effectively (plan); understand their strengths and weaknesses (monitor); reflect on, and improve their learning (evaluate).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will be starting with the number system and consolidating key facts from Year 1. We will be focusing on addition and subtraction, multiplication and place value. Emphasis is being focused even more so on the reasoning behind these concepts. Children need to know their number bonds to 20 and will be working on their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p> <p>TTRockstars and Numbots should be practiced regularly.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>We will start the year by studying a traditional tale ‘The Gingerbread man’. Throughout the term, children will develop their writing skills through the use of this book and a number of other texts used for comprehension, guided reading and whole class reading.</p> <p>Spellings will be given out each Friday on our interactive platform — Spelling Shed and the children will be tested on the following Friday. Login codes will be provided in their home school records. Please encourage children to play the games to embed their spellings.</p>
