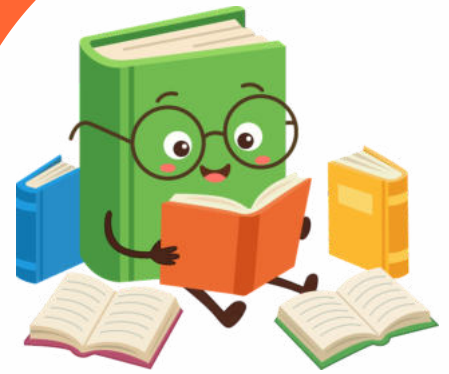

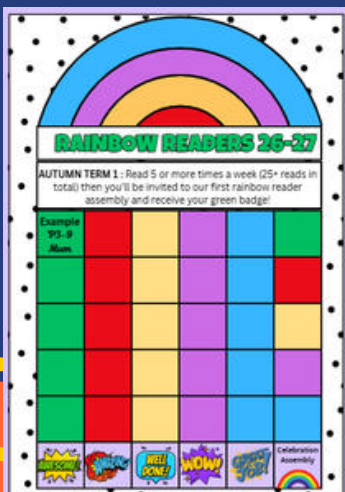
Thank you to parents and carers for supporting the book fair last week at school, it was lovely to see so many children browsing the shelves and selecting a good book!

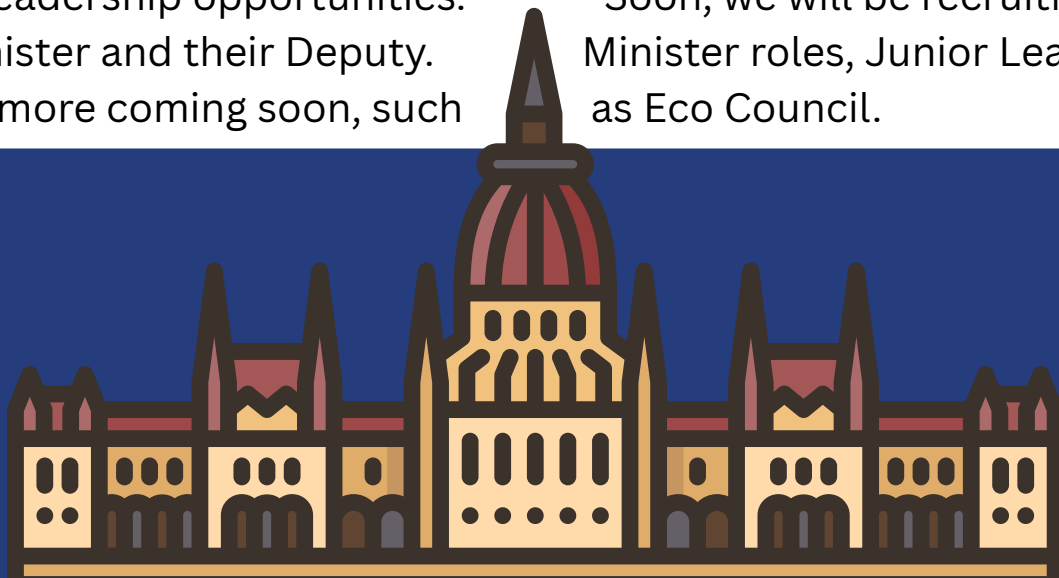

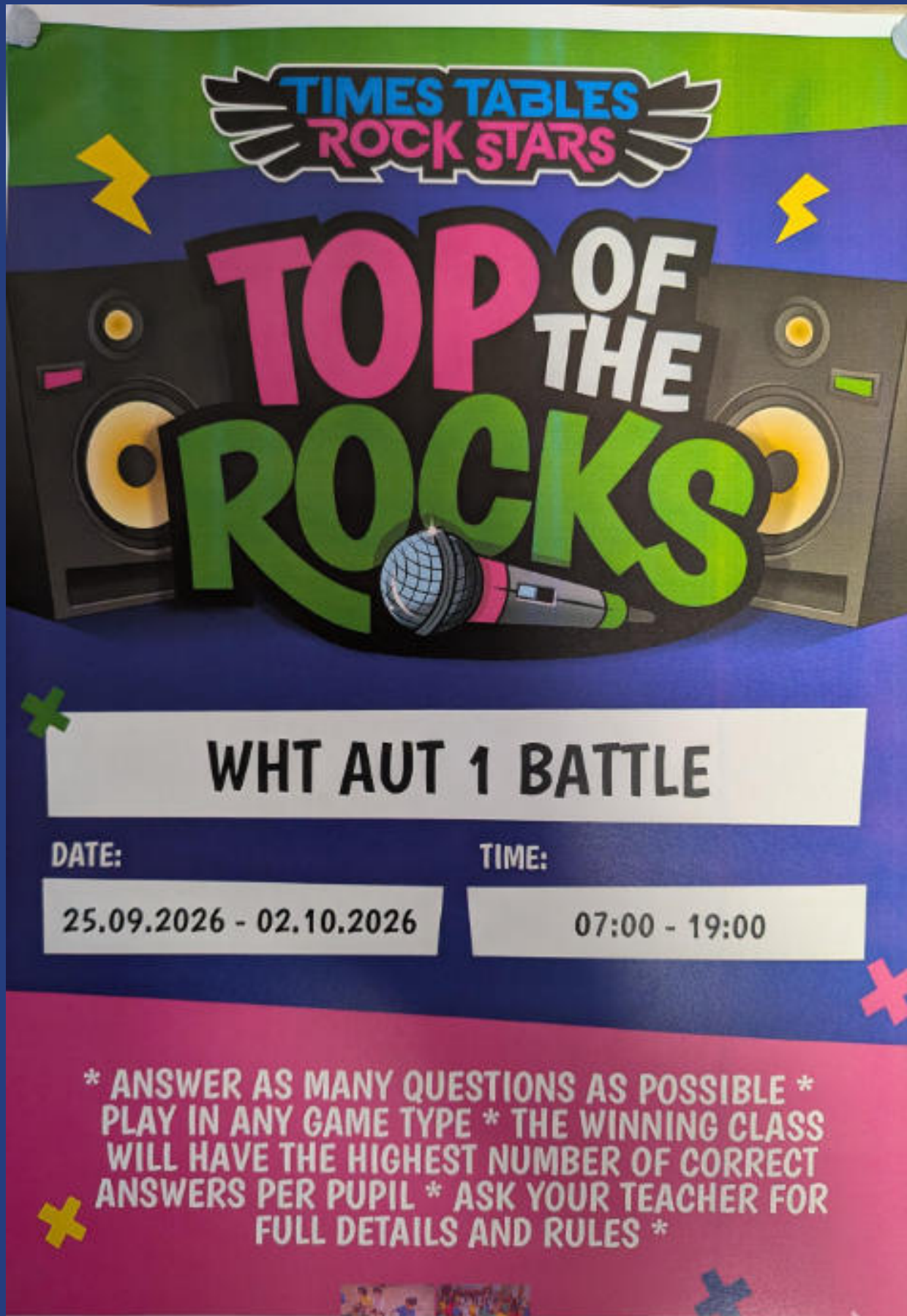
