ROAD SAFETY WALKING HOME

For any Year 5 and 6 children who walk home, can you please remind them of some simple safety rules when walking home:

- choose safe routes that use pavements and pedestrian crossings, especially along some of the busier routes
- do not cross in between parked cars or on corners, this limits visibility for both the child and driver
- keep focused, avoid walking home looking at a phone, this can be a distraction

Children in Year 6 are permitted to walk home once parents have requested permission in writing. This can be done through the office.

Children in Year 5, in the summer term, are permitted to walk home (once parents have made a request), if they live within a certain distance from school, we make this judgement on individual cases with safety being our first priority.
