Please send a message back or let Miss Guest know if you can come and how many adults will be coming to allow us to set this up.



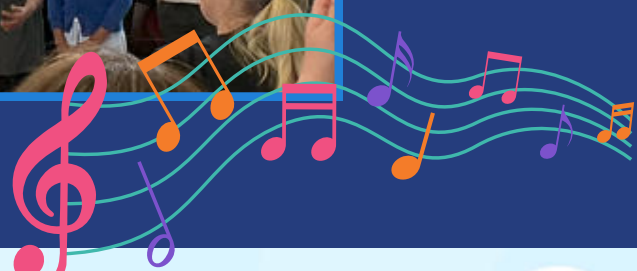
# FAMILY OF SCHOOLS SINGING FESTIVAL
