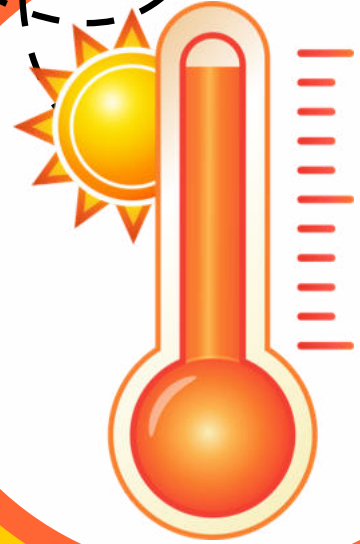

Mrs Rogers and I hope you found it informative and helpful.

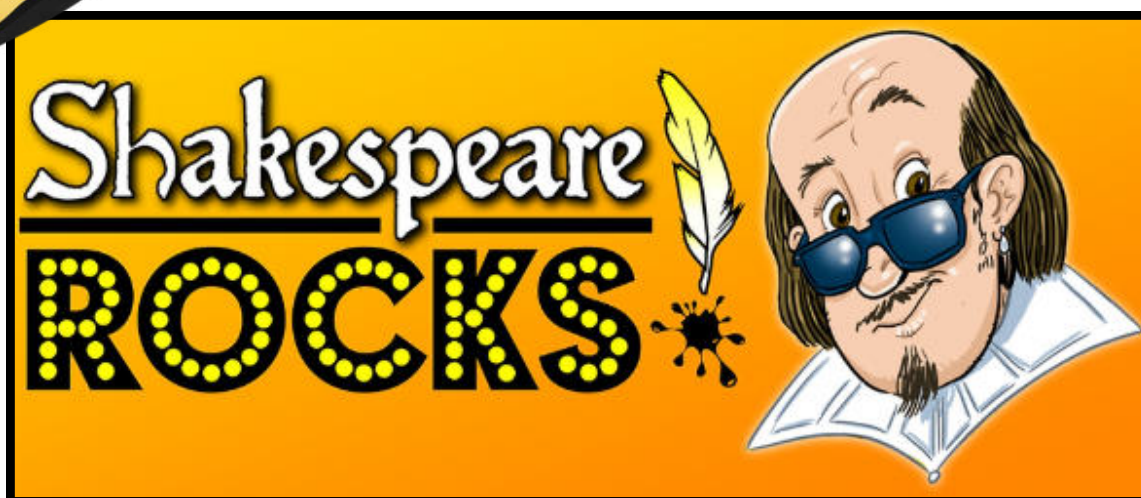
For those parents who were unable to attend the meeting notes will be emailed out.
