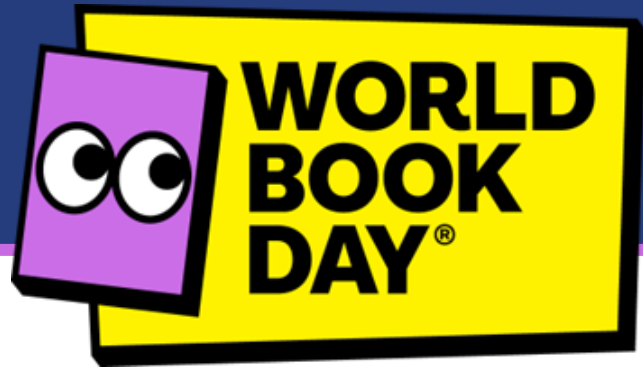


JOHN CLIFFORD SCHOOL BULLETIN
