Understanding the World We will:  - Use photographs and labels around the classroom.  - Make our own playdough and make familiar objects with this.  - Develop the construction area and model use of different materials.  - Provide different tools around the classroom and

Physical Development The children will: - Move along to favourite songs and action rhymes during daily phonics Sing songs relating to body parts Have opportunities for children to draw and write Provide opportunities for children to explore different textures through malleable play.	Personal, Social and Emotional Development We will: - Discuss and make class rules Teach children to use and care for materials and encourage them to do this independently Talk about what we like to do/ how we can help / share/ be kind etc Play name games to help learn each other's names.	Communication and Language The children will:  - Use imaginative talk in role-play, small world play and puppet play.  - Begin to listen attentively at carpet times and when accessing play opportunities.  - Talk about personal experiences in class and group circle times.
Expressive Arts and Design The children will: - Explore tools for painting; brushes, sponges, rags and fingers and use these tools to print patterns Make an area of the classroom specifically for displaying models safely and explain that this needs to be respected Encourage children to paint pictures, which can then be displayed.	Personal Social Health Education (PSHE) We will: - Identify people in our class and how they are similar or different Talk about how they, and others, show feelings, talk about their own and others' behaviour, and its consequences, and know that some behaviour is unacceptable Work as part of a group or class and understand and follow the rules Adjust their behaviour to different situations and take changes of routine in their stride.	Ideas for home to support  - Talk about important people in your family.  - Find a picture of a special time with your whole family.  -Draw a picture of all the members in your family.  - Read to your child in any language.  - Join a library and borrow books.
