


Registration

To register for an account to make an eAdmissions application, please visit the website www.eadmissions.org.uk and then choose the option to "Register"



Registration 2: New Account

Please enter your Title, First name, Last name and Postcode. Once these have been entered, please click on the "Search" button to find your address.


On this screen you will need to enter your contact details.


Please enter your email address and at least one phone number before clicking "Continue".

Registration 4: Set password

You will now need to choose the password for your eAdmissions account. Please enter it the password box and then re-enter in the box below. The password complexity rules are displayed at the top of the screen.

Once your password has been entered, please review the privacy policies before ticking the box and then clicking "Create".

Registration 6: Sign In



Details 1 Child Details

On this screen you will need to enter your child's name and date date of birth. Please make sure the name is as it appears on their birth certificate.

You will also need to confirm their gender and that they live at your home address before clicking "Save and continue"


Please note that if your child lives at a different address you will need to provide a supporting document that confirms the living arrangements.

On the next screen you will need to confirm if your child is from a multiple birth (twin, triplet etc.) before clicking "Save and continue"

Please also tick the appropriate box if either of the following applies to your child:

Your child is in care of a local authority (are a 'Looked After Child' under the care of social services) or were in care of a local authority immediately prior to adoption, special guardianship order or child arrangements order. If ticked evidence from your social worker must be provided.


Your child has an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).



Details 2: Current School

Select the option that applies to your child before clicking "Save and continue".

If your child is <u>not</u> currently attending a school or nursery, is educated at home or educated abroad go to step 3.




To enter your child's current school/nursery use the drop down box to select the borough that the school/nursey is located in.

Now choose the name of the school/nursery that your child attends from the list. before clicking "Save and continue".

If your child's school/nursery is not in the list check that the location is correct.

If the location is correct click on the link "School/nursery not listed above?" to enter the name manually.





Details 4: Second Contact

You can choose to add a second contact who can act on your behalf regarding the application by completing this section.


If you do not wish to enter a second contact tick the box before clicking "Save and continue".

Please note that admissions staff will not be able to discuss details of the application with anyone not entered as a contact on your application form.

Details 3: Relationship Details

Please confirm your relationship to the child by selecting the appropriate option in the drop down menu. You will also need to confirm if you have parental responsibility before clicking "Save and continue".

Please note: If you select "Other relative", "Other Contact" or do <u>not</u> have parental responsibility you must provide a supporting letter confirming the child's living arrangements.



You have now completed the 'Details' section of the application and your child will be shown on your home page with the following links:

- Edit child details
- Start new application
- Delete child details

If you are ready to select your preference schools move on to the next steps. You can also exit and return later by selecting the "Start new application" link under your child's name on the home page.

Preferences 1: Add School

You may apply for up to 6 different maintained schools in or outside the Borough of Ealing.

Click 'Add school' to begin adding your school preferences.



List the schools you want to apply for. You can list up to SIX schools.

- · Make sure you have read the Admissions Policy for each school you have listed.
- The Admissions Policy is the set of rules which will be used to decide the order in which children will be offered the available places.
- Make sure you list the schools in the order you prefer them. If you qualify for more than one school, you will only be offered the one which is higher on your list.
- · Once you have selected your schools you will need to select 'Confirm selection'

You can search for schools in three ways.

Select "Map" to view schools by location Select "Keywords" to search by the school name.

In this example we will select a school from the "List". First you will need to select the Local Authority where the school is located, then select the school from the list before clicking "Continue".

The next screen will provide you with information specific to the chosen school.

Please ensure that you read this carefully and follow any additional instructions on applying for the school before clicking "Continue".

Please note that some schools require you to complete a supplementary information form. This will be displayed here with details on how to complete the form.

If you do not follow the guidance your child will not be considered correctly against the school's criteria and you may miss out on a place.

Preferences 2: Add Sibling

You will need to confirm if there is a sibling who will still be attending the school before clicking "Continue". Please make sure that you read the definition of sibling before you select yes or no.

If you have selected "No" go to step 3.

Is there a sibling (brother or sister) who will be attending this (or a linked) school?

The words brother and sister refer to all blood, half, foster, step and adoptive brothers and sisters (not cousins) who live at the same home and in the same family unit as the child on a permanent basis, or for the majority of the time, in any calendar year.

Submit 1: Add Another School
