

**Topic: Put your wellies on!**

<p><b><u>English</u></b>          In phonics we use the Read Write Inc Scheme. Children will be learning sounds in the RWI order. They will practise their new sounds in their reading and writing. Each week we will have a different grammar focus but will be particularly working on capital letters, full stops and adjectives. They will have a book sent home weekly that they should be able to access using their phonics.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b>          In maths we will be using our knowledge of number to begin to count in groups/lots of amounts. This will lead on to the children learning how to count in jump of 2s, 5s and 10s. After this we will teach the children multiplications and division problems using the vocabulary lots of, groups of and sharing.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b>          This half term we will be looking at animals. We will be looking at the key features of a fish, bird, reptiles, mammals and invertebrates. We will be using the scientific skills of grouping, making observations and collecting evidence. At the end we will create a fact file including all the information we have learned.</p>
<p><b><u>Geography</u></b>          This half term we will be learning about the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom as well as naming and locating the five oceans. We will use atlases and globes to help us identify the United Kingdom and its countries. We will be looking at geographical similarities and differences between towns and the country. We will also be looking at human and physical features using geographic terms such as beach, cliff, mountain, farm, house village.</p>	<p><b><u>Art/ Design Technology</u></b>          This half term we will be designing a house for a town or a city. We will use a range of techniques to draw and design our community including sketching and painting. We will start by looking at the London skyline. We will build our designs using cardboard, glue, masking tape and plastic. Finally we will paint our design and review it against its purpose.</p>	<p><b><u>Physical Education (PE)</u></b>          We will be focusing on different skills including throwing and catching a ball and working as a team. We will be looking at using our body to balance when performing a movement. We will also look at the value of team work and becoming reflective team players.</p>
<p><b><u>Computing</u></b>          We will be focusing on logging into a computer. We will be learning about the importance of Internet safety. We will also be using the programme JIT to add text and pictures to a document.</p>	<p><b><u>Personal Social Health Education (PSHE)</u></b>          This half term we will be learning about the difference between wants and needs. We will be discussing people who are less fortunate and planning a charity event to help raise money for them.</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b>          This half term we will be continuing to work on singing in pitch focusing on high and low pitch. We will be introducing notes of the scale and we'll introduce and play percussion instruments.</p>
<p><b><u>Religious Education (RE)</u></b>          We will be learning about different religions and the foods that are sacred. We will be discussing food prepared at different festivals including, Christmas, Eid and Passover.
