

<p><u>English</u> In phonics we use the Read Write Inc Scheme. Children will be learning sounds in the RWI order. They will practise their new sounds in their reading and writing. Each week we will have a different grammar focus but will be particularly working on adjectives and adverbs. They will have a book sent home weekly that they should be able to access using their phonics.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> In maths we will be continuing to count forwards and backwards to 100. We will also start to count forwards and backwards in 10s, 5s, and 2s. We will continue to look at our number bonds within 10 and using them to answer missing number problems. We will also be comparing numbers and learning about odd and even numbers.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> This half term we will be looking at the four seasons and the different weather in each season. We will also be looking at different tools used such as a rain gauge, which is used to collect rain. We will then collect all the data and use graphs to record our information. We will discuss how clouds are formed and the extreme weather in some countries.</p>
<p><u>History</u> In history we will be learning about what history is and what historians do. We will discuss how we know about the past look at a range of historical sources. We will compare London from the past to London in present. We will also create our own family tree.</p>	<p><u>Art/ Design Technology</u> In art this half term we will be looking at lines and how they can be found in everyday objects. We will be exploring different lines with different materials and how artists used lines in their paintings. We will also compare different paintings and how they used different types of lines.</p>	<p><u>Physical Education (PE)</u> This half term we will be looking at different athletic events. We will look at skills needed to sprint, run a relay and throw a javelin. We will continue to work as a team and prepare for sports day.</p>
<p><u>Computing</u> This half term we will continue to learn about programming algorithms. We will look at creating our own animation. We will look at the importance of giving clear instructions using arrows and programming Beebots.</p>	<p><u>Personal Social Health Education (PSHE)</u> In PHSE we will continue to look at what makes a good friend and how we can be a good friend. We will also start to look at how to keep ourselves clean and how to keep safe at school and at home. We will discuss our different families and what happens as we grow older.</p>	<p><u>Music</u> This half term we will be continuing to discuss rhythmic values and to express them with whole body movement. We will also learn about crotchets, minims and semibreves.</p>
<p><u>Religious Education (RE)</u> This half term we will be focusing on sacred places such as a mosque, a church, a synagogue and a temple.
