

Topic: The Romans

<p>English We will be writing a diary entry about being a soldier in the Roman army and children will write an advertisement for a new person to join the Roman army. Then children will be writing a story about what life was like in Britain during the invasion of the Romans.</p>	<p>Maths We are going to be reasoning about the location of a two digit number in a sequence as well as identifying what the next ten will be. We will also then be looking at the terms ‘difference/how many more’ and end our year focusing on precise language with 2D and 3D shapes.</p>	<p>Science – Plants We will be learning about the different uses of parts of a plant. We will be writing in detail about the different plants and learning what they need to survive. We will be planting our own beans and taking care of them in class as well as writing instructions for how to look after and plant seeds.</p>
<p>History – The Romans We will be learning about when the Romans conquered Britain. We will be learning about what life was like before the Romans invaded Britain as well as what life was like during the invasion and the impact of Romans on modern day Britain.</p>	<p>Art We will be using Matisse’s ‘Cut-Outs’ to explore colour, shape and textures. The children will be using organic shapes and complementary colours to make their own ‘Cut-Outs’. The children will be looking at how Matisse uses his art to show a feeling.</p>	<p>Physical Education (PE) We will start to prepare the children for sports day. The children will be taught to complete races while embodying team work and positive sportsmanship as well as learning how to adapt their own style.</p>
<p>Computing We will be focusing on learning how to use different computer programs with music. We will also begin to programme using coding and directional language.</p>	<p>Personal Social Health Education (PSHE) We will be learning what pride means and what it means to be proud of an achievement. We will be exploring different scenarios when we might feel conflicted with our emotions and learn how to regulate ourselves in these emotions. We will also be looking at what it means to be a good friend.</p>	<p>Music This half term we will be looking at beat, rhythm and crotchets in written music.</p>
<p>Religious Education (RE) This half term we will be focusing on personal beliefs and understanding that every religion has common moral ties about how to act as a human in the world.
