

Topic: Spatial senses and Baghdad 900cc

<p>English In English this term, children will be writing a historical narrative, diary entry and a non-chronological report based on our text, 'The Children of Winter' by Berlie Doherty. We will continue to learn about grammar (relative clauses, adverbial phrases and modal verbs). We will also concentrate on devices to avoid ambiguity and use conjunctions for writing cohesive texts.</p>	<p>Maths In maths this half term, children will be learning about number and place value. They will continue to consolidate their knowledge and use of times tables up to 12 x12. They will understand tenths using decimal fractions for addition and subtraction and also round numbers with tenths to the nearest whole number.</p>	<p>Science In science this half term, the children will learn about the properties and changes of materials. They will learn about reversible and irreversible changes and will know how mixtures might be separated using comparative and fair tests.</p>
<p>Geography/History In geography this term children will be learning about features used to locate places on maps (e.g. longitude and latitude). In history they will be learning about Baghdad in 900CE. They will learn about the spread of Islam, building and destruction of Baghdad.</p>	<p>Spanish In Spanish this half term children will learn how to say numbers 1 to 30 and months of the year. They will learn how ask and answer what the date is.</p>	<p>Physical Education (PE) In P.E. this half term the children will learn how to improve their skills in team sports. They will also learn how to dribble a ball while keeping it under control and move quickly away from defenders. They will also learn how to assess their fitness levels.</p>
<p>Computing In computing this half term, children will be learning about sharing information. In this unit, learners will develop their understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices.</p>	<p>Personal Social Health Education (PSHE) In PSHE this half term children will be learning about health and wellbeing. They will learn what is meant by a healthy lifestyle and how to maintain physical, mental and emotional health and wellbeing.</p>	<p>Music This term in music we will focus on body movement and spatial awareness. We will repeat all rhythmic values introduced in previous years and we will create rhythmic themes which will then will be arranged by students into choreography.</p>
<p>Art/ Design Technology In art this half term the children will study 'Style in Art'. The children will learn about Rococo and Modernism and be able to compare these art styles. The children will experiment with designing and painting their own modernist art work.</p>	<p>Religious Education (RE) In RE this half term the children will be learning about Buddhism. They will investigate Buddhist images, what is it like to belong to a Buddhist community and they will learn who Buddha was and what his teachings were.</p>	<p>Ideas for home to support Children should : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read 15-20 minutes every-day out loud. - Learn their times tables up to 12x12. - Learn their weekly spelling- they will be tested weekly on a Friday. </p>
