



<p><b>English</b></p> <p>We will be exploring the book, 'The Windrush Child' by Benjamin Zephaniah. The children will be using this text to write a non-fictional text: arguments and a formal letter to the Prime Minister. They will be exploring on how to improve their writing with appropriate vocabulary and querying if they had met the purposes of their audience.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In maths, the children will be focusing on revising the four operations and solving problems involving those operations. They will also be revising fractions, decimals and percentages and make comparisons between them. In addition, they will be revising ratio, algebra and completing measurement reasoning problems.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>The children's learning will build on the units of 'Animals including Humans' and 'Living Things and their Habitats'. They will learn about fossils, habitats and human development in order to grasp the concepts and ideas. They will learn about variation and adaptation. They will also learn about the scientists Charles Darwin and Alfred Wallace.</p>
<p><b>Personal Social Health Education (PSHE)</b></p> <p>In PSHE, the unit is 'relationships', the children will discuss the qualities of a good friend, what a healthy relationship looks like and will recap puberty from Year 5. They will be looking at male and female changes during puberty and understand the human reproductive system.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Photography and creative design.</p> <p>This term we will explore photography as a creative art form, using techniques such as photomontage, digital editing and composition. We will experiment with different ways to create images, including macro photography and recreating artwork using props and staging. We will develop our skills in framing, lighting and focus, and learn how to edit images to achieve different effects.</p>	<p><b>Physical Education (PE)</b></p> <p>This term we will develop our skills in sprinting, jumping and throwing through a range of track and field activities. We will improve our sprint start technique, learn the phases of the triple jump, and practise the heave throw for distance. We will take part in team challenges such and develop jumping skills including the scissor jump. We will work collaboratively to record and evaluate results, building towards a final competition where we apply and refine our techniques.</p>
<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Our geography unit this term will focus on globalisation. We will be looking at how international trade can be made fairer for producers in developing countries. We will end the unit with a debate about the pros and cons of international fair trade.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Performance and staging.</p> <p>This term we will learn and choreograph songs for our school production. We will read the script, discuss characters, analyse stage movement. We will discuss how to effectively practice, rehearse and present performances to audiences with a growing awareness of the people watching.</p>	<p><b>Ideas for home support</b></p> <p>Encourage children to read as much as possible.
