



<p><u>English</u> In our writing unit, we will be studying the novel, 'Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief' by Rick Riordan. The children will be writing their own Greek myths taking inspiration from the novel's characters and settings. The children will explore the main character by writing a diary.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> In maths, the children will be learning about coordinates and how to translate and reflect shapes within a coordinate grid. In addition, they will be looking at converting units of measurement to solve mathematical problems. They will be looking at how to solve perimeter, area and volume of shapes.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> In the unit, 'Evolution', the children will be discussing the concepts of inheritance, variation, adaptation and evolution by natural selection. They will understand that fossils are evidence of evolution (a change over time) and how fossils provide evidence for evolution. They will learn how use data and diagrams to deduce and draw logical conclusions.</p>
<p><u>History</u> In their history unit, 'The History of Human Rights and Equality in Britain', they will discuss what human rights are and that the United Nations established the Universal Declaration of Human Rights following the atrocities of the war.</p>	<p><u>Spanish</u> All about the school setting. In this unit the children will learn how to repeat and recognise the vocabulary for school subjects, say what subjects they like and dislike at school and tell the time (on the hour) in Spanish.</p>	<p><u>Physical Education (PE)</u> In PE, the children will be learning how to play tennis and other field sports such as cricket. They will practice to show some ability to maintain control of a ball on a racket while moving; successfully catch and control a ball on their racket and move their feet to attempt to improve their position for catching a ball.</p>
<p><u>Computing</u> In their unit, 'sensing', learners will be introduced to the Micro:bit as an input, process and output device that can be programmed. They will use the buttons to change the value of a variable using selection. They will develop their programs to update the variable by moving their Micro:bit using the accelerometer to sense motion.</p>	<p><u>Personal Social Health Education (PSHE)</u> In PSHE, the unit is 'relationships'; the children will be discuss how beauty is portrayed around the world, know that they have the right to say no and learn basic first aid skills. Furthermore, they will explore friendships and online friendships; they will recap what a good friend is.</p>	<p><u>Music</u> The children will be preparing for their musical production: Ali Baba and the Bongo Bandits. The children will be practicing music and dance routines for their performance.</p>
<p><u>Art</u> In art, the children will be studying the unit, 'Impressionism'. They will look at the work of Monet, exploring how they broke from the norm by painting outside, using rapid brushwork and painting landscapes.</p>	<p><u>Religious Education (RE)</u> In RE, the children will look at what happens in a Gurdwara and how Sikhs show many symbols of respect when they are there. They will look at how Sikhism promotes expressing equality through their religious practices within the Gurdwara. They will discuss that anyone is welcome in a Gurdwara, but there are certain rules to follow.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> In the unit, Africa, they will be introduced to the African continent and will begin by looking at the diversity of the continent. Pupils will locate physical geographical features of the continent such as the coastlines, the equator, the Atlas Mountains, Mount Kilimanjaro and the Sahel region. They will know that Africa is rich in minerals and resources.</p>
