# Does my child need to wear the school uniform?

Yes, children are required to wear a John Perryn school jumper or cardigan along with black trousers and a white polo shirt.

### My child has English as an additional language, how is this supported in school? Teachers value the children's needs and, when it is possible, provide opportunities for children to use their home language. The school has staff who will work with these children and support parents.

# How are children with special needs catered for?

Each child's individual learning requirements are planned for by the teaching staff. Where a child may have particular needs or disabilities, the staff work closely with the parents to meet these needs. The school has specialist staff that will support children with SEN.
