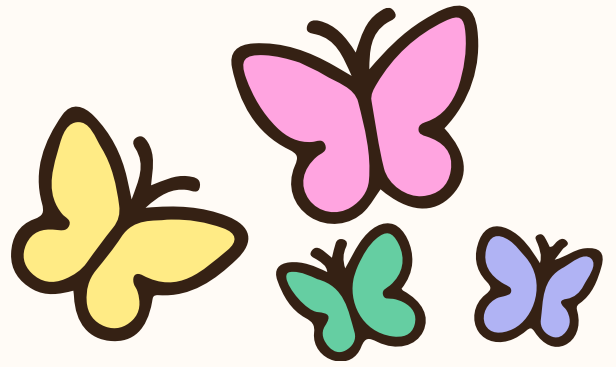

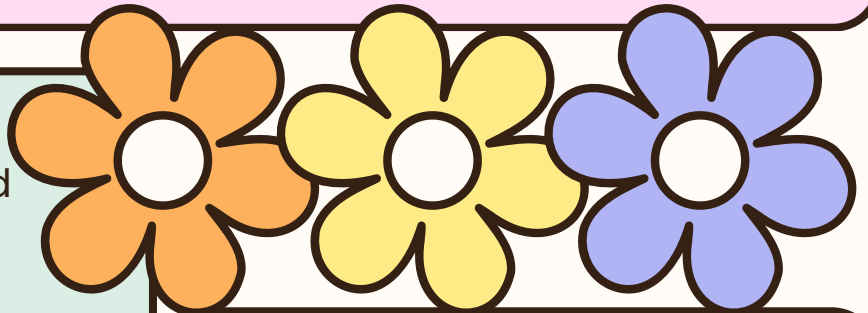
## Summer 1: Stomp, Stomp... Roar!

- Explore shapes and patterns



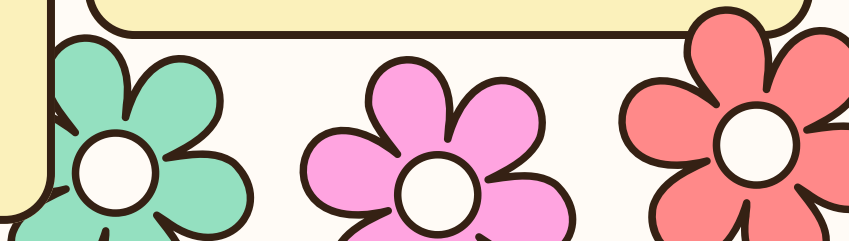
### Phonics
