Key messages:

We will be learning how to describe Writing a newspaper report on a natural disaster, Designing ways of staying safe in a disaster and learning how to market our designs, writing explanation texts to show how these disasters occur.

In Computing, we will be identifying and correcting:

- off-by-one **bugs**
- multithread bugs
- conceptualbugs
- arithmetical bugs
- resource bugs.


In Music, Some will be continuing Violin with Music Masters. Year 3 will be continuing to take part in Music lessons provided by Music Masters.

In Maths we will be:

Continuing our learning of Addition and Subtraction — In year 2 we will be taking one digit numbers away from 2 digit numbers and year 3 we will be looking at 3 digit numbers and taking away from them. Year 2 will be using informal methods such as number lines.

We will be starting to look at formal multiplication and Division Methods.

In PE, We will be continuing Multi Sports. We will be learning basic skills like running in different directions, following instructions, catching, throwing, and throwing at a target. Throwing at a



In PSHE, we will be completing the 'Celebrating Differences' Unit.
