Ideas for Home learning

- Make a Kenya fact file Find out and write 3–5 facts about Kenya (flag, animals, capital city).
- Create a safari animal collage Use drawings or magazine cut-outs to make a picture of African animals.
- Try some Kenyan music Listen to a traditional Kenyan song and draw how it makes you feel.
- Design a Kenyan-style necklace or pattern Use coloured paper, pasta, or beads to create bright patterns.
- Weather diary Keep a short diary comparing the UK weather with Kenya's weather for a week.
- Learn a greeting in Swahili Practise saying "Jambo!" (hello) and use it with your family at home.



In Geography, we will be learning

- We will explore where Kenya is on a map and learn it is part of Africa.
- Children will find out what it's like near the Equator and learn about Kenya's climate.
- We'll discover Kenya's landscapes, like mountains, savannas, and national parks.
- Pupils will learn about Kenyan wildlife and why people go on safaris.
- We'll compare life in Kenya with life in the UK, looking at homes, schools, and culture


In English, We will be learning

- We are reading Lila and the Secret of Rain.
- Children will talk about the characters and setting.
- They will retell the story through speaking, drawing, and drama.
- We'll write our own versions using full sentences and exciting words.
- Children will learn new vocabulary and practise punctuation.



In Maths, we will be learning

- about time, including reading clocks to the hour and half hour.
- Children will explore money, using coins and notes to make amounts.
- We'll practise measuring length, height, mass, and volume.
- Pupils will solve real-life problems using addition, subtraction, and other skills.
- We'll keep building confidence with number facts and times tables.





In Science, we will be learning

- about animals, including humans, and how they grow.
- Children will name and group animals by what they eat (herbivore, carnivore, omnivore).
- We'll look at how animals change as they grow, including life cycles.
- Pupils will learn about the importance of exercise, food, and hygiene.
- We'll observe and record information about ourselves and other animals

In RE, We will be learn

- about why the Bible is a special book for Christians.
- Children will hear Bible stories and talk about their meanings.
- Pupils will explore how Christians use the Bible in daily life and worship.

In PE, we will be learning Tennis

- to hold a racket and control a ball.
- We'll practise hitting, aiming, and rallying with a partner.
- Pupils will develop coordination, footwork, and teamwork skills.

In Music, We will be continuing our learning of the violin with Music Masters.
